Because of his background in emergency room medicine and surgery, he was hired by Spectrum Healthcare to be an emergency department physician (ED) in Oahu. He eventually became the company's Chief Medical Officer – responsible for overseeing 800 physicians in government facilities throughout the U.S. Today, Dr. Miscovich has a booming, state-of-the-art practice offering comprehensive medical care. His medical staff consists of 6 physicians and 12 advanced practice providers in Kanohe. Besides primary care physicians, there are integrative health/rehabilitative and orthopedic specialists on staff. In addition, the clinic has psychologists, physical therapists, acupuncture specialists, massage specialists, nurses and support staff, for a total of around 100 employees. With 20 exam rooms, blood labs, x-rays and other diagnostic services, his clinic is one of the premier medical facilities in Oahu.

The Hawaii Medical Association recently named Dr. Miscovich as Hawaii's 2019 Physician of the Year because of his exemplary leadership in the field of medicine and commitment to providing quality care to patients. Besides a large staff of 100 employees, including specialty physicians, his clinic offers one-stop shopping for patients. They can get blood tests, x-rays and other diagnostic services on-site. His office has extended hours, and his medical team provides home health visits and telemedicine services. Most importantly, Dr. Miscovich and his staff treat patients like family. He has an office dog that provides emotional support and his patients are encouraged to bring pets to their appointments.
